



Consumer Confidence Index



What I'm seeing in my law practice

- Layoffs, furloughs and reduced salaries from smaller "corporate" aggregators
- 2. Fewer job offers
- 3. Limited leverage (negotiation ability)
- 4. Practices are less efficient and teams are tired!
- 5. Some aggregators have stopped buying
- 6. "Wait and see" approach






COVID-19 Economic Recovery






